- One 10'x10' space will be provided for the festival. Neither your tent nor goods may extend past your contracted space.
- Each nonprofit will be limited to two (2) participation passes per day.
- You must be set up by 4:00 p.m. Friday night. You may not begin to break down until the event is over on Sunday night after 11:00 PM or the following day (Monday, August 23 2021).
- **Limit 2 cars per nonprofit for parking.** All nonprofits must park in assigned areas; no parking is available on the festival route. Additional cars will be directed to designated public parking areas.
- There are no guaranteed locations. The festival is configured based on the route.
- **Tables, chairs, electric, and water are not provided.** Nonprofits may bring a generator.
- All garbage must be put into dumpsters.
- Alcoholic beverages, fireworks, pornographic/sexual material, or offensive material is not permitted. Wawayanda Music on the Farm is a family-friendly event and reserves the right to refuse any questionable nonprofits.
- **No fires will be permitted whatsoever.**
- We are not responsible for lost, stolen, or broken merchandise.
- Nonprofit personnel will not harass, threaten, or abuse any person or organization involved with Wawayanda Music on the Farm. If a verbal or physical situation does arise with nonprofit/personnel, the participants will be asked to leave and/or be removed by the authorities. The nonprofit will not be permitted to participate at the festival. We take safety seriously.
- A valid certificate of liability insurance must be submitted with your application naming Brian Ford, Dean Ford Sr., and Barbara Ford, 284 Hortons Road, Westtown, NY 10998 as loss payee.
- Your cancelled check serves as your receipt.
- **No refunds.**
